Cyril Garvey once said, "If you are lucky enough to have just one good idea and work really hard on it, it makes life all worthwhile." The house at 782 Ellicott Street, Buffalo was just such an idea.





THE KEVIN GUEST HOUSE STORY

We are fortunate to have state of the art health care right in our backyard. Imagine if you had to travel many miles and stay away from home for days, weeks or even months to receive critical care for either yourself or a loved one. Where would you stay? How would you afford it? That is the reality for the families who stay at Kevin Guest House.

It was January 1972 when 13-year-old Kevin Garvey passed away. He had spent the last 18 months fighting leukemia, spending much of that time at Roswell Park Memorial Hospital. While at the hospital, Kevin's parents, Claudia and Cyril, witnessed the hardships of other families, who slept in their cars and waiting rooms because they were unable to afford lodging.

The Garveys wanted to help those families, so they purchased the property at 782 Ellicott Street and opened their doors in July 1972, welcoming people to Kevin Guest House. More than 60,000 guests, coming from Western New York, 49 states, Canada and 11 other countries, have stayed with us since then.

Located on the Buffalo Niagara Medical Campus, Kevin Guest House was the first healthcare hospitality house in the United States. We provide a comfortable home away from home for patients and their families who are seeking critical medical treatment at Buffalo-area hospitals and medical centers.

In August 2018, our campus grew to four properties as we opened the **Russell J. Salvatore Hospitality House** on the Kevin Guest House Campus, making us fully accessible for the first time and allowing us to serve more families. Our two main houses combine to offer 10 guest rooms, four family suites, common living and dining areas along with amenities from free laundry service and breakfast to our beautiful garden. The Russell J. Salvatore Hospitality House also includes two apartments, giving our campus a total of eight units which allow bone marrow and other transplant patients an environmentally safe place to recover within the required distance to their medical facility. In 2022, the KGH50 Campaign began to bring the oldest three buildings on the Kevin Guest House campus to the same standard as this newest building, in order to maximize capacity and serve our quests in the best environment for healing.

In our 50-year history, there are not many individuals that have continued to make an impact for Kevin Guest House as much as Jamie Scotland and his lovely wife, Gail, and we are honored they've accepted our 2023 Kevin Garvey Award. They are one of the kindest, most steadfast volunteers our organization has had the pleasure to call part of our



family for the last decade and why we created a brand new 10 Year Club with Jamie as our first official inductee as board members who have served.

50th Anniversary - The Garveys helped to start the healthcare hospitality movement that continues to directly impact guests today...

Our namesake, Kevin Garvey was nicknamed "heart" by his family, which inspired our logo and that of hundreds of homes across the world. Before Kevin sadly succumbed to his illness, he was able to see the houses that would be named after him, but passed away on January 14, 1972. His parents Cyril & Claudia continued their work to honor Kevin's legacy and opened the house to its first guest on July 26, 1972, with the support from then Roswell Park Memorial Hospital, so that future generations of patients & caregivers could focus on

their health and worry less about the financial burdens that accompany life threatening illnesses away from home.

As brother Denis said, over the last 50 years, "Kevin Guest House has become a beacon of hope providing shelter, comfort, and understanding to those in times of incredible need." Now there are more than over 600 similar organizations worldwide and that small idea of the Garvey family has impacted millions along with over 60,000 families traveling to Buffalo for life-saving care. A treasure in the heart of the Buffalo Niagara Medical Campus and one of the very best examples of the City of Good Neighbors, the work we do, directly provides the dignity, compassion and the "family" our guests need in some of the hardest days.

As brother Hugh said "Kevin was only with us here on Earth for 13 short years but he has left a good and kind and everlasting footprint on our world."

"Kevin's house is filled with his spirit. It shines through all of you who open his doors to all those in need. May God continue to bless you and all those who keep Kevin's memory alive", said sister Mary.

As we remember our history, reflecting on the impact our small house with a big heart that represents a young boy from Pennsylvania who lived a life full of strength, courage and a lot of heart, we hope you will continue to open your hearts to our mission in this next year.

Affaire of the Heart, as our signature event, helps support a significant portion of our annual operating budget to maintain our four-building campus and provide quality service to our quests. Kevin Garvey was nicknamed "heart," given after a family vacation because of his kindhearted nature. His mother Claudia said, "in the eighteen months that Kevin lived with his illness, that finally conquered even his stout heart, he served constantly as a model and an example for all of us." Reflecting on the past 50 years, much has changed on campus, but the heart of our mission has always remained. As brother Hugh said, "Kevin was only with us here on Earth for 13 short years, but he has left a good and kind and everlasting footprint on our world. May Kevin Guest House continue to serve those, like Kevin, at their

most needed time, with a place of comfort, love, and life. As sister Mary said, Kevin Guest House "shines through all of you who open his doors to all those in need".

As the inspiration for the Kevin Guest House, he was known of his open heart and loving spirit. In that tradition, the Kevin Garvey Award is given to a unique individual or organization that opens their heart to our home, showing their support and devotion to our guests and to the mission of Kevin Guest House. Kevin's siblings and family are asked to consider some of the most influential supporters of the house in recent history to honor with such an award. This year, we're honored to celebrate the first inductee into a new 10 year club, Jamie Scotland, former board president who alongside his wife Gail provided unwavering volunteer support over the last decade.

Tribute to Jamie Scotland "THE KINDEST VOLUNTEER"





Jamie's Leadership Guided KGH through the Pandemic...

When Jamie Scotland was introduced to Kevin Guest House by former board member, Geanne Zanatta, he was working as a senior financial planner and vice president for Key Private Bank. He told us he was hooked on day one, when he could see the direct impact even one person's efforts could have on our guests.

We are so fortunate that Jamie's love and commitment to KGH ultimately led him to the role of board president. With his financial planning prowess, and 20 years of service as a career missile launch officer for the United States Air Force, Jamie brought discipline to our budgets and our meetings. Now firmly rooted, that discipline helps us plan our strategic annual mission, making it easier for our staff and our committee to achieve mission goals together.

Jamie oversaw some of the brightest financial years in KGH history helping us grow from less than \$400,000 in 2013 to over \$1,000,000 in operating revenue planned for 2023 alongside two multi-million capital campaigns launched during his tenure. He guided the creating of our investment and gift policy plans, including the move of our endowment to the Community Foundation of

Greater Buffalo. That move helped set KGH up for long-term sustainability to be able to weather the next unexpected financial crisis. More recently, Jamie led our organization through one of the most difficult financial times of the COVID-19 pandemic.



He worked tirelessly throughout those early pandemic years, searching for ways to keep our doors open including the payment protection plan keeping our staff working and other government & foundation support only available to organizations consider part of the front-line workers. Without his tireless detail over our budgets, we may not have remained an essential service & kept our doors open to the most immune compromised patients who needed us most through the pandemic.



Jamie believed in our ability to take on another capital expansion, in the height of the pandemic & it's critical necessity to undertake now. As this was one that would renovate the KGH original homes to the same standard as the Salvatore House that was the best environment for the weakest patients to be close to their life saving care. He encouraged the board to take that step now, so that we could continue to serve as many quests as possible for the next 50 years.



In retirement, his strong ties to KeyBank and the First Niagara Foundation encouraged our first ever gift of over \$175,000 to launch the KGH50 campaign. Without that initial commitment, our confidence in this campaign could not be realized. Considered one of our largest long term contributors, Jamie's relationships has kept the Keybank Foundation as an important partner as annual donors and bringing groups of volunteers to the house. Jamie and Gail were also one of our first donors to our 2015 expansion campaign by lovingly naming one of our transplant recovery apartments in memory of Gail's sister Betty Granger and even donated her dining room table that served as the meeting place each night for guest gatherings that served as one of the most memorable parts for both families & volunteers. Lastly, the Scotland's were one of the first to become members of the Cyril & Claudia Garvey Society members by leaving Kevin Guest House in their will.

Alongside these years-long efforts, Jamie and his lovely wife Gail volunteered at the house in countless ways: delivering flowers and homemade pies to donors, prepping for events, cleaning at the house, entering data during busy weeks, and attending nearly every event with a crew of new KGH friends. While we know he has moved on from the board to spend more time with family, Jamie and Gail will always have a special place in our hearts and homes.

THE 10 YEAR CLUB Jamie's genuine nature, his ability to motivate a group and his sincere belief in our mission encouraged fellow board members to create a "10 Year Club" in his honor. This special designation will be featured on a new donor wall planned for house installation during our renovations.

2023 KEVIN GARVEY AWARD WINNER Jamie was a natural choice for the 2023 Kevin Garvey Award, which is being presented to him by Kevin Garvey's sister, Margaret Garvey Condon. This award is our highest honor, bestowed annually to one person who has gone above and beyond by opening their hearts to our guests, and reflecting the nickname of our namesake Kevin "Heart" Garvey. We hope you will join Kevin's siblings in honoring Jamie Scotland throughout this year as one of our kindest, patient, detailed & fiscally minded volunteers our Kevin Guest House family has ever had the pleasure to call a lifelong friend.

Kevin Guest House is going high-tech by going mobile with our silent auction bidding. You can now place bids online with your smartphone or mobile device.

Register online at **AOH23.givesmart.com** or text **AOH23** to **76278**. You'll receive a text message with a link to your own personal bidding center.

LET'S GET STARTED!

How to bid

Once you have completed a registration on the campaign, you will receive the welcome text message, linking you to the items to browse, bid or buy.

- ♥ Click on the Blue link in the Welcome text to be directed to the Items page.
- **♥** View Items by category or search by Item number or name.
- Click the item of interest to view the description as well as the current bid and or price.
- The system will auto-populate the bid amount based on the set increment for the item.

Choose to bid at the set amount or higher.

Click Bid.

HOW TO PLACE AN AUTO BID

Allow the system to automatically bid up to a designated amount for you. The system will bid incrementally up to the amount designated as long as someone else places a bid against you. If no one bids against your auto bid, the price remains the same.

- ♥ Click the item of interest
- Click the Auto Bid tab
- ▼ Enter in the maximum amount you would like to bid
- ♥ Click Bid

Note: When two bids are placed for the same amount, the bid placed first based on the timestamp wins. Timestamps are set when the initial bid is placed, for auto bids this is when a maximum was set not when the system prompted the bid to win. This is a preventative measure for auction sniping.

HOW TO TEXT TO BID

As a user, you have the ability to send texts to place bids on silent auction items.

- ▼ Text the keyword to 76278 to register
- **▼** Text the ITEM NUMBER and AMOUNT

Example: To place a \$1000 bid on Item 101, text "101 1000"

▼ Receive a leading bidder confirmation text message



"This past summer, I began my journey to fight a leukemia diagnosis which involved several weeks of chemotherapy at Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center. Not living in Buffalo, there were times my wife and I needed to stay nearby to avoid the added stress of excessive travel. We couldn't have been more fortunate and blessed for an introduction to Kevin Guest House and its outstanding team, Following my stem cell transplant this past fall, it became more critical to stay close to Roswell, as I required regular follow-up visits. It was apparent right away that the excellent housing accommodations, the many food donations and the dedication and compassion of the staff was overwhelmingly heartfelt.

KGH understands the special needs of cancer and transplant patients like me, continually raising donor funds to make the improvements and upgrades necessary for guest safety — even more so today, because of the pandemic. The KGH properties not only provide a well maintained and home-like atmosphere, but have the added benefit of the many intangible benefits that the staff and team extended to us through their personal service. They made us feel like family members and not merely guests. As cancer patients, the anxiety, fears and stress associated with treatment is often more than enough to handle. Feeling welcome and cared for by everyone at KGH eased our burdens dramatically. I couldn't express enough how much we highly commend the KGH for those in need. 




